Community: Airports are community assets needing careful planning to maximize the value of aviation with community businesses to minimize conflicting or negative growth and planning.

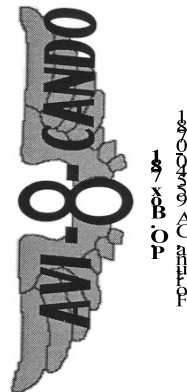
Education: To enhance aviation as a vocation, avocation, or for personal development and enjoyment especially with our youth.
